<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Non – Mass Days</u></p> <p>PreK- 8th: Navy blue polo <u>or</u> white polo with logo, with khaki pants or shorts (no cargo pants or shorts) or White polo with logo with navy-blue pants or shorts (no cargo pants or shorts)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Non – Mass Days</u></p> <p>PreK-5th: Navy blue or white polo with logo, with khaki skort or plaid skort (no more than 2 1/2 inches above the knee, no shorts)</p> <p>6th-8th: Navy blue or white polo with logo with khaki skirt or plaid skirt (no more than 2 1/2 inches above the knee, no shorts)</p> <p><u>Girls in 6th – 8th grade are not permitted to wear skorts. Skirts may not be rolled or gathered at the waist. Students who have skirts more than 2 1/2 inches above the knee will be sent home for the day, and face disciplinary consequences.</u></p> <p>PreK-8th: khaki pants (no capris, leggings or stretch pants)</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Mass Days</u></p> <p>1st- 8th: White oxford shirt with logo with plaid tie and with navy blue pants</p> <p>No shorts. <u>A belt is required.</u> Students must have their shirt tucked in.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Mass Days</u></p> <p>PreK-5th: White Peter Pan blouse with plaid jumper (no more than 2 1/2 inches above the knee)</p> <p>6th-8th: White oxford with logo with plaid skirt (no more than 2 1/2 inches above the knee). Students must have their shirt tucked in.</p>
<p><u>Shoes:</u> Brown, black or white, preferably non streak. Shoes may be dress shoes or sneakers. Shoelaces must match the color of the shoe.</p> <p>Only <u>PreK and K</u> students may have Velcro closures.</p> <p>The shoes may have a small amount of trim of a different color. Shoes that light up or have any other unique specialty feature are not permitted.</p> <p><u>Socks:</u> solid white, blue, black, brown</p>	<p><u>Shoes:</u> Brown, black or white, preferably non streak. Shoes may be dress shoes (flats, no heels) or sneakers. Shoelaces must match the color of the shoe.</p> <p>Only <u>PreK and K</u> students may have Velcro closures.</p> <p>The shoes may have a small amount of trim of a different color. Shoes that light up or have any other unique specialty feature are not permitted.</p> <p><u>Socks:</u> solid white, blue, black, brown. Tights or leggings of same colors may also be worn during the cold weather. If leggings are worn, then socks must cover ankles.</p>
<p><u>Accessories:</u> A blue, black or brown belt must be worn for boys in 1st through 8th Grade.</p>	<p><u>Accessories:</u> Hair accessories must be simple navy blue, yellow, white, or school plaid.</p>
<p><u>PE Uniform:</u> 3rd- 5th may wear their PE uniform to school on PE days.</p>

3rd- 8th: Gray SFCS T-Shirt with school logo (short or long sleeve). Navy blue shorts (no shorter than mid-thigh) or solid navy sweat/ athletic pants and sneakers. **Middle schoolers need to bring their PE clothes to school to change into.**

Optional Outerwear

The following items are permitted to be worn in the classroom during the school day. Other outerwear may be worn to school and on the playground but are not permitted to be worn during the school day.

- Navy sweater vest or cardigan with logo
- Navy piped athletic jacket with logo
- **6th-8th grade:** Navy fleece jacket with logo. These items may not be worn in church.
- **Hoodies may not be worn at SFCS.**

Jewelry PreK-8

Girls may wear (1) small set of earrings. These must be stud earrings and may not be dangly. If girls have a second piercing, it will need to be taken out during school hours. **Girls may not wear Kendra Scott necklaces.** Boys are not to wear earrings. Students may wear one (1) Christian/Catholic medal or sacramental on a thin chain inside their shirt or blouse. No bracelets or rings may be worn, even if religious. No nail polish. No artificial nails. If nails are done for a special event, prior approval must be given from the principal. No make-up. A simple watch may be worn. **No Apple or other “smart” watches may be worn.**

Hair

No unusual or fad haircuts that draw attention. Hair must be off the collar, above the ears and eyebrows for the boys. Students’ hair color must be their natural color.

Male Students:

Hair must be clean, natural, and styled so that the hair does not cover ears or eyes and is above the shirt collar; no extreme or trendy hairstyles are permitted. Sideburns may not extend more than halfway below the top of the ear. Must be clean-shaven. Facial hair is not permitted. If a male student is notified by their teachers or the administration that they need a haircut, students have the weekend to get one. For example, if told on a Thursday they would need to have a haircut by Monday morning. Students who do not comply face disciplinary consequences.

Spirit Days, Game Day Dress Codes

There are many opportunities throughout the year in which students will be able to come to school “out of uniform”. On these days students may wear pants (jeans, cargo pants, athletic pants) and/or shorts/dresses/skirts that are not excessively tight, short (**shorts/dresses/skirts must be no more than 2 1/2 inches above the knee when standing**), and/or revealing. Jeans may not have torn holes in them. **Yoga pants, pajama pants or excessively tight leggings are not permitted.**

Shirts and blouses should be modest in coverage as well as in content. The regular policies regarding jewelry, makeup, and hair still apply on days in which the regular uniform is not required unless specified differently. Fridays are Spirit Days. Students may wear their regular uniform bottom with a SFCS Spirit top. Middle school students should wear House t-shirts on Thursdays.

Student athletes may wear their athletic jersey in place of their regular school uniform top on days in which there is a game or match. Athletic jerseys may not be worn on Mass days. A plain white t-shirt is acceptable to be worn under the jersey. Students must be in their regular uniform pants, shorts, skirts, skorts, shoes, and socks during school on game days.

The final decision regarding the appropriateness of clothing items and the possibility of disciplinary action on non-uniform days is made by the principal.

If you have uniform questions, please ask them prior to the Uniform Exchange and/or before purchasing new uniforms. New purchases are to comply with the skirt length requirement which is 2 1/2 inches above the knee. Girls who are not in compliance with the dress code will be sent home and/or face disciplinary actions (lunch detention, after school detention, Saturday School, etc.)
